Next week our PTA will be holding the Macmillan Coffee afternoon at 2.30pm as well as their AGM to kick-start the cycle of fundraising for good causes and the school itself. Everyone is welcome. The event will be held in the hall. At the end of the school day children will be collected as normal but then have the opportunity to come into the hall to take part and buy some cakes for

themselves. (Tip: don't let the teachers at the cakes first – I've seen what happens to cakes in the staff room and there may not be any left by 3.16...)

All the teachers have worked incredibly hard to make the start of term successful for all of our children. I am very grateful for their effort and commitment to the school. Thank you for your continued support.
