Thank you for attending our pupil-led learning reviews this week. I am delighted at the way the children have been able to share the work that they are proud of and talk about their learning with real insight and enthusiasm. For each pupil we have a clear picture of strengths and we are constantly assessing areas to improve. Feedback from parents has been overwhelmingly positive. I am pleased at how we, as a whole school community, have joined together and placed the children at the heart of everything that we do.
