Dear Parents,

It has been such a successful year for Frogmore; there have been so many things to celebrate and there are still lots of things to look forward to. Our joint Summer Fair seems like a perfect way to start the last few weeks of term which is really all about transitions. I hope to see everyone at the Summer Fair tomorrow and I am looking forward to seeing you at some of our shared assemblies and events that will mark the end of term.

### **New Classes Day**

On Thursday 5th July pupils will get to meet their new teachers. We will talk about the year ahead and each teacher will send a letter to you as a way of welcoming your son/daughter and preparing for September. At the same time our Y6 pupils make the transition to secondary school and will be spending the day at their chosen school for Year 7. 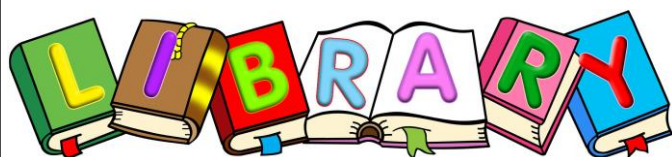


### **Please support Lili-May**
