### National Maritime Museum, Greenwich - Hazel & Maple Class

To support our topic of British History and Values, Hazel and Maple classes are being invited to attend a school trip to the National Maritime Museum in Greenwich.

The historic buildings of the National Maritime Museum form part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site including the Royal Observatory and 17th-century Queen's House. Children will be able to stand on the Prime Meridian of the world, where east meets west, at the Royal Observatory - home of longitude and Greenwich Mean Time (GMT).

This is an incredibly exciting venue where children can 'jump back in time' to discover characters from Britain's maritime past including Admiral Lord Nelson and Grace Darling.

The trip is on Wednesday 20th March and will cost £17.00 - this includes the cost of the coach; entrance to the museum is free of charge however there is a small charge for the workshops. The coach will leave school at **8.00am** and return by **5.00pm** (subject to traffic). Please return the permission slip and payment by 14th February 2019. We rely on parental contributions to be able to run trips like these - please note that if insufficient funds are received the school will need to cancel the trip.

The children will need to be in school uniform and bring a packed lunch and snack with them. They do not need to bring any money with them as we will not be visiting the gift shop.


