Times Tables Rock Stars



Times tables help with mental arithmetic. Memorising tables makes it far quicker and easier for children to work out maths problems in their heads. It can also help to develop the ability to internally add, subtract and divide! This week, your child has brought home a letter all about Times Table Rock Stars. This letter explained what TTRS is and how they can log in from home and practice their times tables.

"In either paper form or online, Times Tables Rock Stars is a carefully sequenced program of daily times tables practice. Each week concentrates on a different times table, with a recommended consolidation week for rehearsing the tables that have recently been practiced every third week or so. This format has very successfully boosted times tables recall speed for hundreds of thousands of pupils over the last 8 years in over 14,000 schools - both primary and secondary - worldwide."
