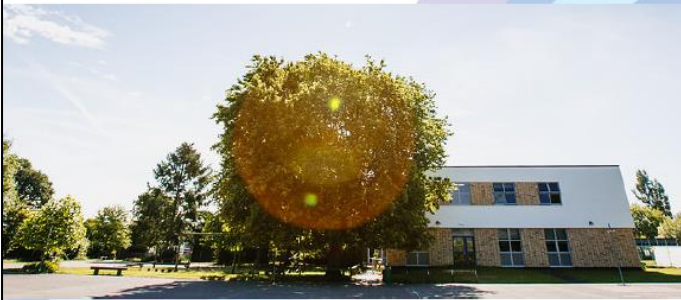

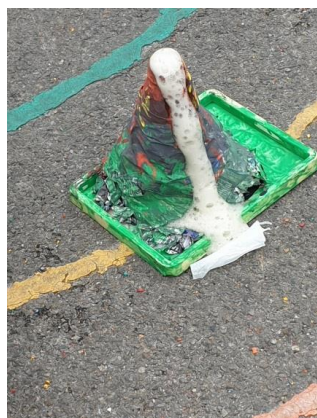

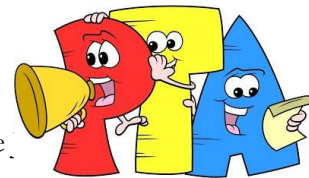
#### School Photographs
